Providing advocacy for Beneficiaries of Social Security Disability Insurance or Recipients of Supplemental Security Income who are interested in working or returning to work



The PABSS program provides the following services to qualified individuals:

- I. Investigation of complaints of improper or inadequate services by a service provider, employer or other entity involved in a beneficiary's return to work effort.
- Information and referral for beneficiaries and recipients about work incentives and employment, including the Ticket to Work and Work Incentives Improvement Act (TWWIIA).

- Information and assistance on work incentives to individuals, government agencies, employment networks and other service providers.
- 4. Consultation to, and legal representation of, beneficiaries when necessary to protect the beneficiaries' rights in the effort to return to work.
- 5. Advocacy in the identification and correction of deficiencies in entities providing Vocational Rehabilitation, employment, or other services to beneficiaries, including identifying and reporting concerns related to the Ticket to Work and Work Incentives Improvement Act.
